SAFETY RULES & GUIDELINES

SPECIAL NOTE: PARADE BEGINS AT 11:00 AM ON SATURDAY JUNE 15th!

1. Parade officials will inspect all entries and reserve the right to eliminate any entry that may pose a safety issue to the public.
2. The Parade will start at the Lyon County Fairgrounds. Entrants should be in the line-up no later than 10:30 am. Parade will begin promptly at 11:00 am.
3. Once your entry has started along the parade route, no one may board the float.
4. Your entry may not exit the parade route before the end of the parade.
5. For public safety, candy or any other type of items may **NOT** be thrown from your vehicle/float.
6. Entries with children under the age of 16 must have one (1) adult per five (5) children.
- 7. All entry spots for lining up are first come first serve.**
8. If you are handing out candy, PLEASE make sure you have enough people to do it so your entry does not slow the parade down!
