Snow Removal Regulations

Parking Prohibited – No parking allowed during snow removal operations **between the hours of 2:00 AM and 6:00 AM on the following public streets:**

- a. Story Street, from North 2nd Avenue to South 3rd Avenue;
- b. Marshall Street, from North 2nd Avenue to South 2nd Avenue;
- c. First Avenue, from Greene Street to Tama Street;
- d. South 2nd Avenue, from a point 300 feet west of Story Street to Marshall Street.

No parking allowed during any precipitation activity, including snowing, drifting or freezing rain between the hours of 12:00 AM and 6:00 AM on all other public streets, alleys or City-owned off-street parking areas.

The City shall make the determination as to whether snow removal is necessary. Because of uncertainty in the weather forecast, owners are advised to remove all vehicles the previous evening.

Sidewalks – Each property owner shall have all ice and snow removed from his/her sidewalk within 24 hours after snowfall. Snow from sidewalks and driveways is NOT to be disposed of in streets, gutters, alleys or other public rights of way.

Violators will be penalized.
