Eligibility

- High School Senior
- At least one city in the school district is a member of the Northwest Iowa League of Cities

Criteria

- Intent to enroll in a post-secondary program that may result in employment by city government (examples: public administration, water/wastewater, law enforcement, firefighter, EMS, code enforcement, planner, public engineer, city attorney, etc.).
- Acceptance and enrollment in post-secondary institution (community college, 4-year college, university, or trade school.)

Scholarship Application Requirements

- Complete and return the application form provided (see attached).
- Submit a 400-500 word essay highlighting candidate's interest in pursuing a career related to city government.

Northwest Iowa League of Cities is an organization founded by community leaders throughout the region working to improve the effective and efficient operation of public service. The organization provides on-going education and networking opportunities - sharing experiences leading to regional success.

All funds used for the scholarship program are generated through private and commercial fundraising.
